

Decolonization of Non-ICU Patients With Devices

Section 13-2 – Staff Huddle Reminder: Device Cleaning With CHG

- Because of the results of a large clinical trial, we provide daily chlorhexidine gluconate (CHG) bathing/showering for non-ICU adult patients with medical devices for the duration of their hospital stay. This includes patients with devices such as central lines, midline catheters, and lumbar drains.
- For **ALL devices** (lines, tubes, drains) clean the 6 inches closest to the body.
- Patients feel uncomfortable cleaning devices. Staff **HAVE TO HELP** clean them.
- Staff: Use clean CHG cloths to clean patients' devices during bed baths and after showering.



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
