Healthcare Extension Cooperatives

- Commitments from state Medicaid programs and safety net healthcare delivery organizations to align and coordinate an improvement initiative
- Collaborative relationships with local or community-based organizations and patient representatives
- Experience and resources for facilitating successful healthcare delivery improvement
- **Infrastructure** to provide and evaluate extension services

National Coordinating Center (NCC)

- **Expertise** in providing a wide range of technical assistance (TA) services
- Expertise in convening learning networks and facilitating learning across participants
- Resources and expertise for convening and facilitating multistakeholder and federal working groups
- Working knowledge of evidencebased tools and resources developed by AHRQ, PCORI, and other organizations

National Evaluation Center (NEC)

• **Expertise** in data, measurement, and multi-method evaluation

Activities

AHRO

Provide guidance to cooperative agreement grantees coordinating AHRQ resources and activities to support the healthcare extension program

Healthcare Extension Cooperatives

- Convene and facilitate a Multistakeholder Council with equitable participation to align programs and payers
- Co-develop healthcare extension services with stakeholders and identify locally appropriate and targeted improvements to healthcare quality and equity
- Facilitate and provide implementation support through workforce training, education, and other direct assistance from healthcare extension agents
- Monitor, evaluate and provide feedback on the success of the Cooperative and its initiative
- Collaborate with NEC and NCC to facilitate learning across the Cooperatives

NCC

- Provide TA to support Cooperative activities
- **Facilitate** cross-Cooperative learning networks to share best practices
- Convene a data and measurement workgroup to harmonize data collection tools, methodologies, and analytic processes
- Provide access to evidence-based tools and resources from AHRQ, PCORI, and other organizations
- Provide communications and dissemination expertise to Cooperatives and AHRQ
- Convene a federal interagency workgroup

NEC

Conduct formative and summative rapid cycle evaluation with monitoring and feedback of actionable data for ongoing program improvement

- Increased capacity to provide healthcare extension services
