Set scope

- Who will use teach-back?
- If you're not ready to use teach-back with all patients, who will your initial focus be? Patients with new medications? Patients with necessary followup? Patients with certain diagnoses, such as asthma or diabetes?

Establish workflow

 Where will you document teach-back in the EHR?

Identify champions

 Who will champion the strategy within each role on the team?

3—Customize training for your practice

- Identify good implementors and use them as peer coaches.
- Continue to promote teach-back and encourage its use.



6 — Evaluate your progress

Evaluate effectiveness

- How many followup questions (calls and emails) do you get pre- and postimplementation?
- Measure an outcome of relevance for your target patient population (e.g., HbA1C for patients with diabetes) pre- and postimplementation.
- What is patient satisfaction with teach-back?
- What is clinician satisfaction with teach-back?

Evaluate implementation success

- Do clinicians report using teach-back?
- Do patients report the use of teach-back?
