

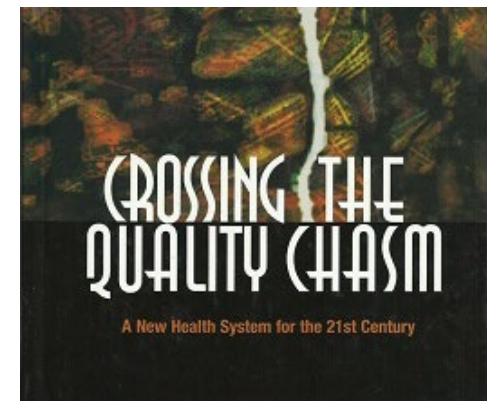
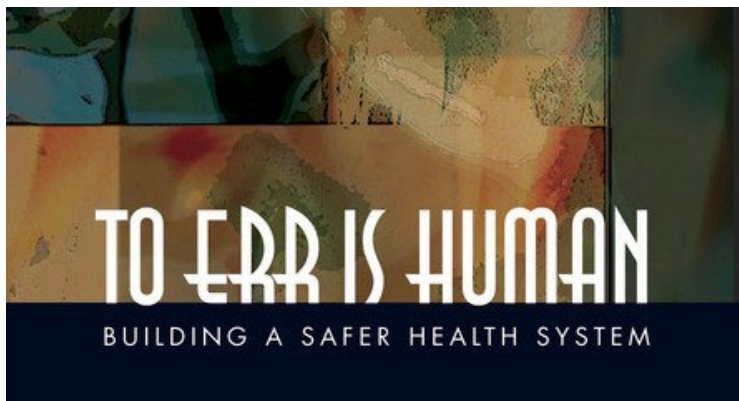

The Importance of Safety Culture

- The 1999 Institute of Medicine (IOM) report that identified between 44,000 and 98,000 individuals die each year as a result of medical mistakes.



Medical Error: A Leading Cause of Death



- Causes of death in US – all ages year 2000
 1. Heart disease: 710,760
 2. Chronic, respiratory disease: 122,000

The Importance of Safety Culture



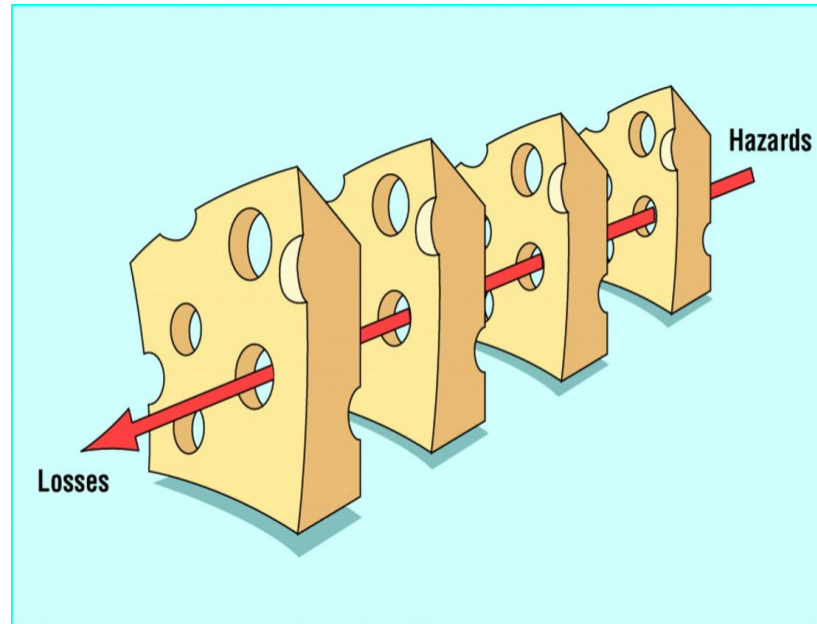
“The most fundamental barrier to improving the safety of patient care – the culture.” (Cooper, 2003)

- Nursing Home SOPS provides staff perceptions of patient safety culture

What Influences Patient Safety Culture?

- Processes of Care (It's the process, not the people)
- *Systems Thinking*
 - ▶ *A culture of blame*
 - ▶ *Staff come to work to do a good job*

Patient Safety Culture in Nursing Homes



- Safety culture scores are lower on average in nursing homes¹
 - ▶ Q. We have patient safety problems in this facility. 38% vs. 53%
 - Nursing Homes vs. Hospitals
 - ▶ Moving, Transferring, or Lifting Residents
 - ▶ Medication errors
 - ▶ Falls
 - ▶ Pressure ulcers
 - ▶ Sanitation

Patient Safety Culture in Nursing Homes



- Safety culture influences staff as well as residents
 - ▶ Overall injury rate for nurse aides is second among all industries.
- Patient safety **MAY** be another problem with the image of nursing homes

- Improving patient safety is about changing organizational culture from one of blame and punishment to one which is just.
