Ambulatory Surgery Centers (ASCs) can voluntarily submit their ASC Survey on Patient Safety Culture (SOPS) data to the ASC SOPS Database. ASC SOPS data can be used for quality improvement purposes.

ASC Eligibility




Your ASC is eligible to submit data if it...

- Is CMS-certified with a valid CMS Certification Number (CCN)
- Is located in the United States or in a U.S. territory
- Provides surgical/procedural services to patients who do not require hospitalization
- Does not share space with a hospital or hospital outpatient surgery department

Requirements

- 1** Administer the ASC SOPS Survey in its entirety
- 2** Complete data collection before July 22, 2019
- 3** Sign and submit the Data Use Agreement (DUA)

Data Submission

-  **Email** DatabasesOnSafetyCulture@westat.com to express interest
-  **Submit data** according to specifications from **June 3 - July 22, 2019**
-  Receive a **free feedback report** displaying your ASC's compared with the database
