- Make the safe thing the easy thing to do


AHRQ's SOPS Program

- Develops validated surveys and measures that are validated
- Supports voluntary data submission to SOPS databases
- Conducts research to further the measurement and understanding of patient safety culture
- Tools to improve patient safety culture in facilities
